 into a trauma-informed environment. This training covers core principles of trauma-informed care,
 strategies to address trauma, and methods to foster equity in the workplace.
- Module 5: Employing Youth with Lived Experiences: Discover strengths-based approaches to employing YYA with lived experiences. Learn about the positive impacts on youth, staff, and organizations, strategies to support staff with lived experiences, and best practices for achieving success in these roles.
